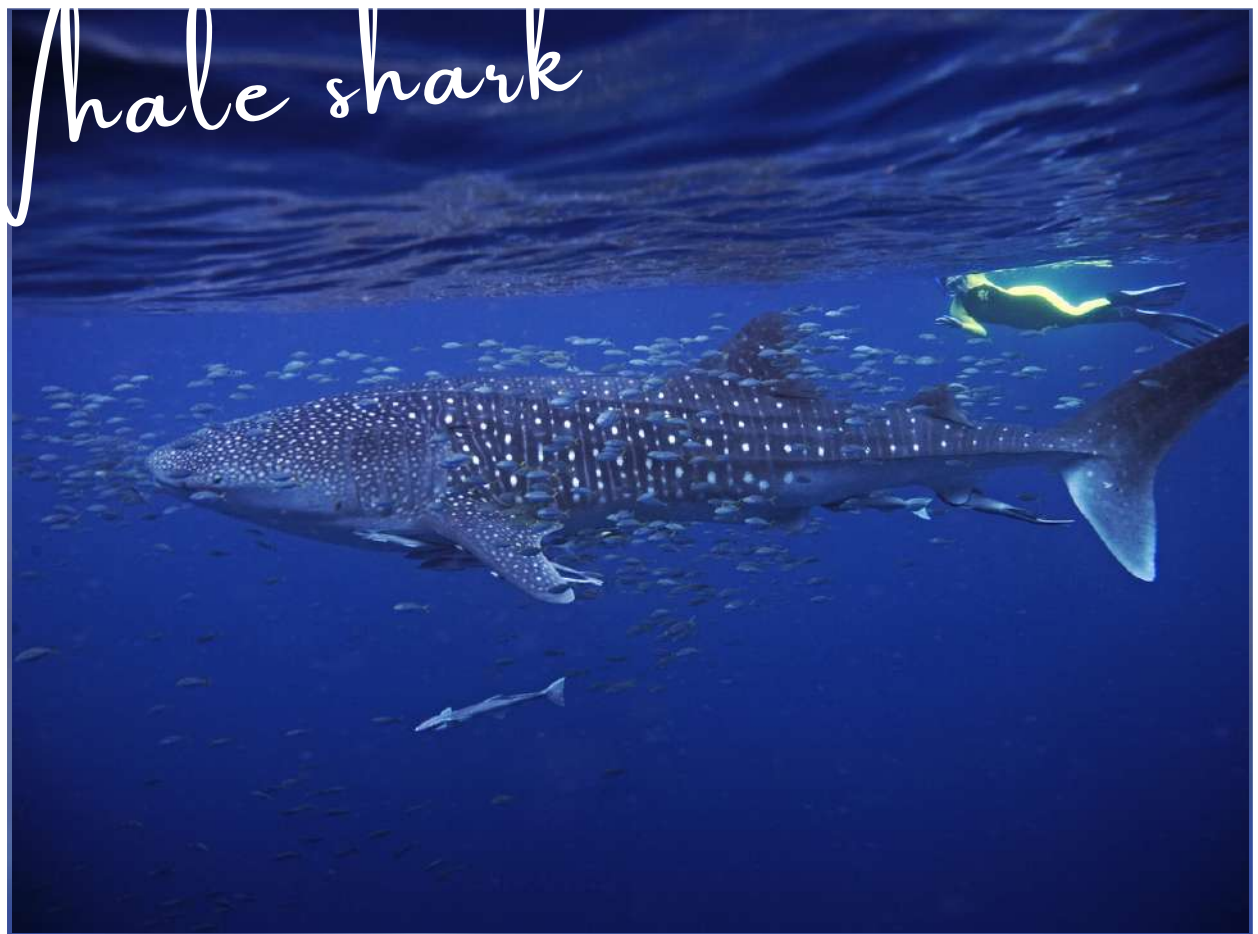


With a focus on high-end inwater interactions. These magnificent ocean giants, known for their elaborate courtship songs and displays, are typically 12 to 16 meters in length and weigh around 36 metric tons. What sets humpback whales apart from other baleen whales are their long, narrow flippers, which are about a third of their body length and scalloped on the forward edge. Additionally, they have distinctive large knobs on their head, jaws, and body, with each knob associated with one or two hairs.

Humpback whales can be found along the coasts of all oceans, including the eastern coast of Africa. They embark on extensive migrations, traveling between polar feeding grounds in the summer and tropical or subtropical breeding grounds in the winter. It is believed that these majestic creatures come to East Africa to give birth in the safe and warm tropical waters. In particular, the waters off the coast of Mozambique have been identified as a significant breeding area for humpback whales.

Morungulo and Tofo, the main focus of our expedition, provide the perfect nesting grounds for pregnant females who give birth to their babies in the shallow reefs off either coast.. These birthing grounds offer our guests some of the most spectacular in-water interactions in the world of whale sightseeing. Accompanied by our professional guides, you will have the opportunity to experience up-close and personal interactions with these magnificent creatures, immersing yourself in their beauty. Enjoy your morning breakfast with breathtaking breaching dances from our temporary residents from your ocean deck.

Whale shark



Whale sharks, the largest fish in the world, can be spotted in the warm waters off the pristine shores of Mozambique. These magnificent creatures can grow to lengths exceeding 14 meters. Mozambique is home to three unique aquatic ecosystems, each offering its own breathtaking wonders. One of the most incredible experiences for visitors to Mozambique is the chance to observe whale sharks up close while snorkeling or scuba diving in the ocean. This encounter is truly magical and has the power to be a life-changing experience. While these gentle giants travel long distances to feed, they can often be found in Mozambique's waters throughout the year, particularly in the Tofo area and forms a big part of our interaction species list when choosing a WHALE OF A TIME EXPEDITION..

MARTINA

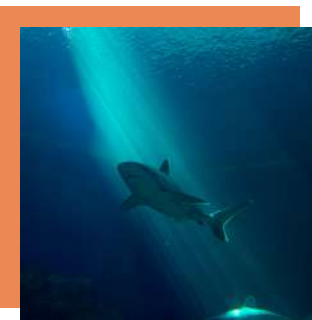

MOZAMBIQUE



Despite its history as an **old Portuguese colony** that ended in 1975, Mozambique has faced challenging times, including severe drought and a prolonged civil war. However, in 1992, peace was finally restored through a **peace agreement** facilitated by the UN. Thankfully, the Mozambican people and their government have moved past their war-torn past and are now dedicated to **rebuilding their nation**. As a result, Mozambique has become an **attractive destination for tourists**, offering stunning beaches, picturesque islands, a UNESCO world heritage site, captivating colonial architecture, and a warm and hospitable people and culture. With all these qualities, **Mozambique has become an ideal place to visit.**



A DIVER'S PARADISE

With over **2000 km of coastline**, Mozambique offers a diverse range of marine habitats.

When Mozambique is mentioned, most divers immediately think of its **abundant megafauna**. The waters are rich in ocean giant possibilities with **whale sharks** and **manta rays**, which can be found year-round in the plankton-rich environment at the forefront of a divers dream. Additionally, **humpback whales** pass through, yearly from June to October, on their migratory route from the Antarctic. The Inhambane region and our focus on this expedition, serves as a

sanctuary for nesting marine turtles, mantas, dolphins and humpbacks on top of a myriad of other special ocean giants. Off the coast of Tofo, an area known as "**whale shark alley**," guests have a fantastic chance to interact with these majestic creatures throughout the year and at our new destination Morrungulo a population of Tiger Sharks has excitedly been discovered. Linking the Shark Mecca of Ponta Do Ouro (tigers, bulls, hammerheads) It is no wonder that these destinations alone puts Mozambique at the top of many scuba divers' bucket lists!

CURRENCIES

- **Mozambique** Meticalais (MZM)
- **South Africa** Rand (ZAR)

These both can be obtained from **all banks with ATM's throughout both countries**. Many places also accept USD, ZAR and EUR but their rates often in restaurants are not favourable. Most places also accepts visa & mastercard.

CASH & CREDIT CARD

When bringing USD or EUR its favorable in terms of currency exchange to **bring larger notes** as the currency value is more than with smaller notes. When bringing specifically **USD make sure the notes are newer notes from 2019** onwards and again the larger notes carry a better exchange than the smaller notes.



One Dollar bills are not accepted nor are coins in any foreign currency

South Africa only!

Currently, there are some **difficulties with making payments using Mastercard** within Mozambique. However, most establishments in Mozambique do accept Visa cards. To ensure a smooth payment experience, it is advisable to **bring a Visa** card as your primary payment method.

For cash, your Safari Drive and Dive Specialist will offer two options. They can either make stops at the various **ATM cash points** along the way, or they can arrange for a **local currency exchange agent** who deals in dollars and euros to meet you at the lodge.

MORE DAYS IN MOZAMBIQUE

The reformed Visa system for Mozambique now **allows every guest 90 days** in the country, not the 30 days total as previously permitted. The simple tourist visa has been converted into an all-in-one tourism and business visa.

Furthermore, **14 countries within the South African Development Community (SADC) region** can also enter Mozambique without a visa for a period of up to 3 months (or 90 days): Angola, Botswana, Cabo Verde, Eswatini, Kenya, Lesotho, Malawi, Mauritius, Namibia, Seychelles, South Africa, Tanzania, Zambia, and Zimbabwe.

Although the visa states that it is valid for a single entry. When visiting South Africa, guests are allowed two entries if it is still within its 30-day validity period.

Most border entry points (flying and land based) have started accepting credit card payments for visas but its recommended to **carry some cash USD** to cover should the machine be offline...

ARRIVAL

HIGH IMPORTANCE NOTE

- Kindly remember to **keep your entry visa receipt or payment slip** with you and present it at the appropriate departure location IF REQUESTED.
- It is crucial to **verify** with the Safari Drive and Dive Specialist **the specific airport from where your expedition will commence / finish before proceeding with the deposit and flight bookings.**
- The Safari Drive and Dive team will accommodate one trip to the arrival and or departure airports. We acknowledge that **arrival and departure times may vary**, especially in today's financially challenging times. Therefore, the team will **schedule the transfer based on the earliest flight times.** However, guests with specific DEPARTURE flights at later times, particularly in the evening, who prefer to spend more time in a comfortable hotel environment, have the option to **arrange a alternate mode of transfer** with the Safari Drive and Dive specialist. Please note that this personalized arrangement will incur **additional expenses on your part.**

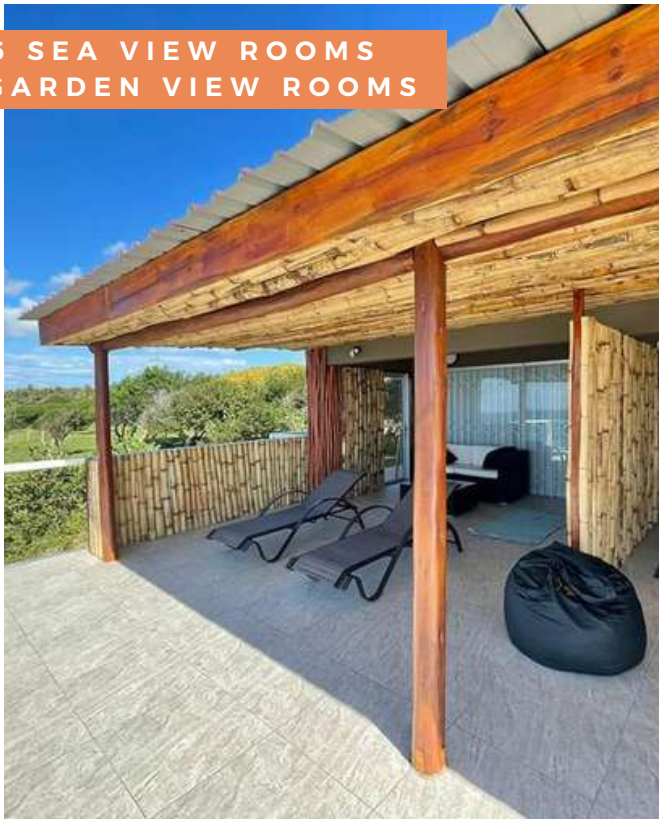

WHAT'S THE GENERAL CONSENSUS ON TIPPING?

Tipping is a wonderful gesture to express gratitude for a well-organized and carefully planned trip, where the staff has gone above and beyond to ensure your comfort and seamless experience at each destination. While tipping is not obligatory, it serves as an excellent way to show appreciation. We kindly ask all guests considering tipping to hand over at the end of their expedition so that your guide can distribute it evenly among the tour team. However, if you prefer to personally tip a specific individual, that is more than acceptable.



WHAT IS A RELATIVE TIPPING AMOUNT?

Typically, we suggest a reasonable amount of \$5 - \$10 per person per day. However, please note that any amount you choose to give is always greatly appreciated by the tour staff.



HOW IS MY LUGGAGE AND DIVE EQUIPMENT TRANSFERRED?

Ideally, guests SHOULD travel with minimal luggage and enjoy the added convenience of complimentary laundry services at every destination. Each day, guests will receive a briefing regarding the schedules for the following day. It is advisable to bring a compact overnight or travel bag, as well as a separate lightweight bag for organizing wet diving equipment during destination changes. At the end of each diving destination, black bags will be available should guests need.



IS THERE WIFI?

WiFi is accessible in all destinations, but the most crucial feature is the availability of WiFi in the vehicle through your guide's phone, which acts as a hotspot.



IS THERE CHARGING PORTS IN THE VEHICLES?

Regrettably NO, before departure ensure that all tablets, power banks, phones, etc. are fully charged.

CAN I GET A LOCAL SIM CARD?

Yes, it is possible to purchase a local SIM card, but it is not necessary since wifi is readily available as soon as you board the bus. If you need a SIM card, you can ask your guide who will be able to arrange it for you at the next suitable opportunity.



IS OUR EVENING MEAL MANDATORY?

Absolutely not at all. Each evening, the group reserves a restaurant option. However, since you are on a holiday and desire tranquility, kindly inform the SDD GUIDE who will be more than willing to provide alternative suggestions and make a reservation for you.

MALARIA

Mozambique is one of the best places to deal with the effects of malaria

Nevertheless, here are some tips to avoid contraction :

- Consult a GP about taking Malaria tablets
- Stock up on mosquito repellent
- Wear light clothing that covers arms, legs, ankles etc.
- Use the mosquito nets provided
- Close doors and windows
- Use mosquito window screens
- Use fan or air conditioner to keep mosquito activity down a minimum

DIVING



ARE 15LTR CYLINDERS AVAILABLE?

Yes they are, but only a certain amount. If a 15ltr is needed please let us know prior to arrival. We stock 10ltr, 12ltr, in both steel and aluminum and all with either DIN or International fittings.



CAN YOU DESCRIBE YOUR DIVING WEIGHTS?

All our weights are 1kg per weight and can be offered for integrated pockets or separate on a belt. If using aluminum cylinders the staff add 1 kg to your ideal weight to counter the lighter metal. If guests are using a 15ltr look to reduce your comfort weight by 1 kg allowing for the slightly heavier and bigger cylinder.



CAN I TAKE A BAG OUT ON THE BOAT?

Certainly, but please keep in mind that we will be diving from a semi-rigid boat, so space is limited. Once again, only pack essential items and hand them over to the guide on the beach for safe storage.



IS THERE AN ASSIST LADDER?

Regrettably not, we can assist directly. Our guides possess remarkable strength and expertise in aiding even the most delicate individuals in returning to the boat. It is advisable to approach the back area, as it is usually nearer to the water and facilitates easier access.



IS THERE SHADE?

Given the nature of our surf launching and the potential for wind to render retractable covers ineffective, it is important for you to bring along some form of light covering. It is essential to have hats, sunglasses, and sunscreens with you at all times.



WHAT ABOUT CURRENTS AND WATER ENTRIES?

Mozambique is famous for its abundant marine life, thanks to the currents that prevail in its waters. Divers need to be well-prepared for the possibility of these currents. Consequently, our dive entries involve descending quickly with the assistance of our experienced guides. Although this may seem daunting, there is no cause for alarm as we have dedicated sweepers who ensure that all entries proceed smoothly. They are the last staff members to descend, and their primary role is to ensure that the dive entries go according to plan.

WHAT EXPERIENCE DO I NEED?

All divers participating in expeditions must possess a minimum qualification of Open Water and Deep, and should be proficient and comfortable in their diving skills. It is recommended that divers have engaged in diving activities within the past six months prior to attending the expeditions.



WHAT HAPPENS IN THE EVENT OF BAD WEATHER?

Regrettably, as divers, we have no control over the conditions of the water and ocean. In the event that dives cannot be scheduled due to unfavorable weather, we will firstly offer an alternative activity/experience of equal value. We have a number of options available to us should the weather not play its part, these will be discussed as a group prior to any decision being made. However, if a guest decides not to dive or participate in the suggested activity change for any reason, they will unfortunately forfeit the activity.



IS A THIRD DIVE AVAILABLE?

The possibility of afternoon dives on your expedition depends on the completion time of your morning activities. These dives are generally shallow and cater more towards the interests of macro diving enthusiasts. The cost of which is paid to the diving center at your dives destination.

PAYMENTS



To secure and confirm the booking date, we kindly request a 20% deposit. The remaining balance should be paid one month prior to your arrival.
